



ITEC Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare Rationale

Qualification Structure

The main aim of the ITEC Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare is to enable learners to gain the necessary practical and theoretical skills in order to provide Facial Skincare Treatments

The ITEC Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare is comprised of 4 mandatory units. Mandatory units = 16 credits.

It also aims:

- to provide skills at Level 2 in the Qualifications and Credit Framework for those interested in the Beauty Therapy Industry
- to provide opportunities for staff in the Beauty Therapy Industry to gain a Level 2 qualification
- to qualify learners at Level 2 in the Beauty Therapy Industry
- to sustain the interest of learners wanting to work in the Beauty Therapy Industry
- to encourage knowledge and understanding of the Beauty Therapy Industry at Level 2
- to provide opportunities for learners to focus on the development of the major functional skills and the wider functional skills in a beauty therapy context, such as communicating with clients, working with others and problem solving
- to provide opportunities for learners to develop a range of skills, techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for successful performance in employment as a Facial Skincare Therapist

Assessment

This qualification will be internally and externally assessed using the assessment of skills as set out below. Once all of the treatment evidence documentation, assignments and underpinning knowledge have been completed, the Learner will have a final practical examination carried out by the ITEC External Examiner, who will also verify a minimum 10% sample of all treatment evidence documentation and assignments

Grading of the Qualification

- a. Learners must achieve a pass grade in all technical and underpinning knowledge units to achieve the ITEC Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare (see assessment table above)
- b. It is the aggregate mark for the practical examination and the multiple choice theory question paper that forms the overall grade of the qualification – Pass, Merit or Distinction
- c. Assignments and treatment evidence documentation are graded pass or refer
- d. If a Learner is unsuccessful in any area, they will be re-assessed only in the unit(s) where they were referred
- e. Referrals must be completed within one year of the original assessment. The remainder of the candidate's results will stay in the ITEC system until all aspects of each unit have been allocated a pass grade

Recommended Prior Learning

It is recommended that learners have achieved a level of education equivalent to five GCSE's at grades A*-C prior to commencing the ITEC Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare; however, exemptions may be made for adult returners with experience of the workplace

Opportunities for Progression

Once learners have achieved the ITEC Level 2 Certificate in Facial Skincare they may progress on to other ITEC or equivalent qualifications at Level 2 and 3, for example:

- Level 3 Certificate in Body Massage
- Level 3 Certificate in Indian Head Massage
