ITEC Policy for Endorsing Learning Resources or Products



ENDORSING LEARNING RESOURCES OR PRODUCTS

In order to endorse any learning materials / products ITEC will need to satisfy itself that the product meets the following criteria:

- 1. It thoroughly covers all the Learning outcomes for the qualification(s)
- 2. It is set at the appropriate level for the qualification
- 3. It thoroughly covers the depth and breadth of the knowledge and skills required to achieve the qualification
- 4. It is suitable for inclusion on a general resource list for ITEC qualifications
- 5. There is no enticement that learners and/or Colleges must use the product
- 6. It does not make claims to be the only resource suitable for the qualification(s)
- 7. It is not misleading in any way to Colleges or leaners
- 8. It is not produced, or has contributions from, anyone who has been involved in the production of the current ITEC exams so as to ensure the confidentiality of the exam/assessment content
- 9. It does not contain any content that would be deemed to discriminate against any individuals that share a particular characteristic (eg disabilities, race, religious belief)
- 10. It does not claim to guarantee a pass for the unit(s) or qualification
- 11. Endorsement of one publication does not imply or grant endorsement of other materials each material/document produced must be subjected to ITEC for approval before any endorsement can be claimed
- 12. Any use of the ITEC name or logo must be in accordance with ITEC branding guidelines
- 13. Any marketing materials must be submitted to ITEC for approval
- 14. Any re-editions must be submitted to ITEC for approval to ensure they still align with the relevant qualification
