Flexibility and accessibility

VTCT has always offered qualifications and assessments in different languages found throughout the UK. However, the uptake would only be those who can fluently read and/or speak the regional language.



The new Welsh bilingual qualifications are in a **mirror presentation method** (as the background image shows). This means all content is in both English and Welsh; showing the content in Welsh first, followed by English, which allows quick, easy comparisons plus the ability to check the meaning of unknown phrases allowing anyone to learn new words.

Learning outcome 1

Same content, different language

The Welsh bilingual qualifications have the exact same content, assessments, prerequisites and funding as the original English versions.

11 quals now available

So far, VTCT has 11 qualifications in the bilingual format. These are across the beauty, hair, complementary therapy and sport sectors. There is discussion for more qualifications to be translated into this format.

Progression

The Welsh bilingual qualifications have the same validity as the original version of the qualification, opening the route for further study or employment for learners depending on which bilingual qualification the learner achieves.

Greater career opportunities

The ability to speak, read and write in Welsh is an **additional skill** which can help you stand out from other job applicants. Studies show that people with bilingual skills can earn a **higher salary**. Being bilingual will open the door to **opportunities** that might not be available to you otherwise.
